We are concerned about the welfare of our children, thus it is imperative that Block Parent members turn in their sign to the local RCMP as soon as possible. Please record your last name and address on the back of the sign and drop the sign off to the St. Albert Detachment located at 96 Bellerose Drive. Anyone seeing a sign displayed after this date should record the address of the home where the sign is being displayed and refer the matter of the retrieval of the sign to the R.C.M.P.

The St. Albert Block Parent Association asks that parents explain to their children the Block Parent Program no longer exists in St. Albert and that a sign displayed in the window of a home no longer ensures it is a safe place to seek help. It is important to establish with your child new safe places for your children to go should they need help.
